

Photography and Videography Policy

The Holocaust Memorial Center allows photography for personal use only. Videography is not allowed on the premises.

Visitors may:

- Take photographs for personal, noncommercial use only
- Use personal cameras, professional cameras or cellphone cameras
- We encourage visitors to tag us in their posts @holocaustmemorialcenter on Facebook, Instagram and Twitter

Visitors may NOT:

- Film videos on the premises
- Use flash photography
- Use tripods, monopods and selfie sticks
- Sell or publish the images or film for commercial use or for profit
- Sell or publish the images or film to promote an unaffiliated product or service

We kindly ask visitors to show respect for the subject matter and the mission of the Holocaust Memorial Center when taking photographs. We also ask visitors to be mindful when taking photographs and not obstruct the view or experience of individual visitors or groups touring the Holocaust Memorial Center.

Please note when taking personal photographs at the Holocaust Memorial Center that all images of artifacts, photographs and other visuals from exhibitions must be properly captioned and credited. It is the responsibility of the visitor to secure all appropriate copyright permission.

The Holocaust Memorial Center reserves the right to withhold or withdraw permission to take photographs on the premises. Holocaust Memorial Center staff have the authority to approach and verify the intent of photography and to enforce its Photography and Videography Policy.

Media Access Policy

Professional filming and photography is permitted by news media for the purpose of editorial news coverage during regular museum hours. Approval must be secured prior to arrival on the premises.

Requests can be made by contacting hmcmedia@marxlayne.com and providing the following information:

- Media outlet and contact
- Purpose of project/story angle
- Deadline
- Desired date(s) for filming
- Exhibit/items to be filmed
- Details of request for interview, if applicable
- Estimated duration of filming including set-up/breakdown

All requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Requests made for same-day photography or filming will be accommodated when feasible.

The Holocaust Memorial Center requires proper attribution and should be credited appropriately. For copyrighted items on display, please obtain proper attribution details from the Holocaust Memorial Center.
