Concert features songs written at death camps

FARMINGTON HILLS — Songs composed by imprisoned musicians in a World War II concentration camp will be performed by University of Iowa professors at Michigan's [Holocaust Memorial Center](#).

The Sunday concert in Farmington Hills is called Songs of the Holocaust. Soprano Rachel Joselson and pianist Rene Lecuona will perform pieces from the Theresienstadt camp in occupied Czechoslovakia.

A release says Joselson used resources from the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum and help from colleagues in Israel and Germany to find scans of unpublished or out-of-print music. She, Lecuona and others recorded an album.

Separately, a University of Michigan ensemble recently performed an arrangement not heard since being played by Auschwitz prisoners.
