

## How Was It Done?

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### Goal:

Students should be able to explain and discuss the complexities involved in taking children from their families and their home countries and resettling them in England.

### Procedures:

Divide students into small groups,

Tell each group that its job is to figure out how to get 300 Jewish children out of Czechoslovakia and resettle them in England.

Each group must write down all the problems involved in this endeavor from soothing homesick children to finding the funds to feed them and finding and paying families to take care of them.

Tell each group to share their list with the class.

Make one combined list of all the problems involved.

Either:

Tell the class how these problems were solved,

Show the class a video that explains how the problems were solved,

Assign individual students to research one of the problems and present their information to the class.
